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Brief Biography

Apostolos Linardis is Research Director at the Institute of Social Research (ISR) of the National Centre for Social Research (EKKE) on "Research infrastructures: documentation and management of social data". He holds a degree in Mathematics from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, a master's degree in Statistics from the Athens University of Economics and Business and a PhD in Social Data Management Systems from the University of the Aegean. He has been working at EKKE since 2000 and on a permanent basis since 2004. In 2004, he was appointed as an Applied Researcher, grade "D", having preferred research to teaching in secondary education, where he had been selected as a mathematics teacher after passing the ASEP examinations. Then he was successfully judged as Applied Researcher with grades "C" and "B", as well as Researcher with grades "B" and "A". He has participated in more than 50 national, European and international projects, either as scientific responsible and co-responsible or as a member of the project team and in different roles: either as a data and metadata manager, or as a statistician and sampling manager in quantitative research, or even as an IT developer. He has participated in key roles in the most important transnational quantitative surveys recently carried out by EKKE such as: the PIAAC survey of the OECD (Programme for the International Assessment of Adult Competencies), the European Social Survey (ESS), the survey of the World Bank "Social Protection Responses to Displacement and Integration", the Values in Crisis Survey (VIC – World Values Survey), the World Internet Project (WIP) and the Eurostat survey on Gender Based Violence. From 06/2019 till 04/2020 he served as Vice President of the Board of EKKE. He is the President of the General Assembly of SoDaNet - the network of the national research infrastructure of the social sciences - , responsible for the Data Repository of EKKE and all technical infrastructures of SoDaNet and deputy representative of EKKE in the Hellenic Open Science Initiative (EPAE). He has taught research methodology at the Department of Social Administration of the Democritus University of Thrace based on the Presidential Decree 407/1980 with the rank of assistant professor, at the Hellenic Open University, in the postgraduate program "Educational Sciences" and in particular in the thematic unit "Educational Research in Practice" as well as in postgraduate programs and university departments that EKKE collaborates with. He is scientific responsible and key lecturer of the research methodology seminar series "Do Your Survey (DYS) using quantitative methodologies and tools", organized by EKKE every six months since 2017.

9. My contribution to my field of expertise (summary)

Social science research infrastructures are a new research field concerned with the development of integrated systems for the accumulation, documentation, long-term preservation, and dissemination of social science data. It is an interdisciplinary field, where concepts, methodologies and technologies of empirical social research, information technology and statistics are used to produce special digital content. Research infrastructures simultaneously manage metadata and data. Of particular interest are the procedures for documentation and management of data and metadata aimed at their long-term preservation as well as unhindered secondary use by third parties.

The use of research infrastructures is a methodological intervention in the way social research is organised. With the development of research infrastructures, the research process is radically

reorganised. The usual research processes of research design, data collection and data analysis are followed by data and research components sharing as well as long-term management with the aim of reusing data and components for secondary analysis and design of new research. It is no coincidence that in the context of projects, funding agencies now ask contractors or even potential contractors to submit a Data Management Plan, in any projects that require the collection of primary data or even the use of secondary data. Data Management Plans document the data management procedures before, during and after data collection as well as the use of research infrastructures and data repositories.

Recently, 'data repositories' are also becoming essential in peer-reviewed scientific journals. More specifically, many peer-reviewed journals in the social sciences - and beyond - require the authors to deposit: a) the data they used in their paper as well as b) the algorithm used to analyse the data, in data repositories so that the analysis can be reproduced by third parties. Otherwise, the paper is not accepted.

It is obvious that the usual procedure followed in research methodology changes and adapts due to the evolution of research infrastructures as well as the new tools of data collection, processing and analysis.

Contribution to research infrastructures

My activity in this specific research field initially took place through my participation in EKKE research infrastructure projects. More specifically, from the beginning of 2000 - when I worked at EKKE as an external partner - I worked on research infrastructure projects under the supervision of Mr. John Kallas. The most important of these were European due to the participation of the EKKE Data Repository (former Social Data Bank - SDB) in the Consortium of European Social Science Data Archives, CESSDA (Consortium of European Social Science Data Archives).

At the same time, my activity in the specific research field continued with the preparation of a doctoral thesis at the Department of Sociology of the University of the Aegean on "Social Data Management Systems", which was graded with "A".

There are now quite a few who deal with research infrastructures in the field of social sciences with an emphasis on documentation systems and data and metadata management. I am in the privileged position to collaborate with these scientists, Greek and foreign, in the context of research projects and to follow closely the developments in the field of research infrastructures, as I am the President of the General Assembly of the research infrastructure of SoDaNet, scientific responsible of the Data Repository of EKKE, administrator of all the IT systems of SoDaNet RI (<https://sodanet.gr/>), deputy national representative in CESSDA (<https://www.cessda.eu/>) and deputy representative of EKKE in the Hellenic Open Science Initiative.

Contribution to quantitative research

Apart from research infrastructures, my research interests also involve conducting quantitative research using digital questionnaire infrastructures and digital case management systems. I have been a member of the core research team and in key - research roles (see above) in large-scale European and international quantitative surveys such as: the OECD PIAAC (Program for the International Assessment of Adults' Skills) survey, the ESS (European Social Survey) of ESS-ERIC, the Gender Based Violence survey (GBV) of Eurostat, the WIP (World Internet Project) survey, the "Social Protection Responses to Displacement and Integration" survey funded by the World Bank and the Values in Crisis survey (VIC) organized by the makers of the World Values Survey (WVS). In addition, I belong to the core research group of the nationwide survey "Public opinion in Greece on the green and digital transition", which is to be carried out through the flagship action of EKKE entitled: "Resilience, Inclusion, and Development: Towards a Fair Green and Digital Transition of the Greek Regions - JustReDI". Finally, I have participated in/organized many smaller scale quantitative surveys. Examples include: the online survey regarding the sources of information and the public's opinions regarding the reliability of public information, the online survey for the evaluation of the project: "Check for entry into the labor market" (which was awarded the first prize for the best integrated applied evaluation methodology by the Hellenic Evaluation Society), the online survey on Immigrant Integration Councils, the survey on the evaluation of the training and counseling support of unemployed and threatened unemployed in the wider area of Piraeus, the survey to capture the current state of volunteering in Greece, the survey for the external evaluation of Health Education programs in primary and secondary education, etc. All the above surveys were implemented using digital questionnaire infrastructures and digital case management systems.

Educational actions to highlight the usefulness and necessity of research infrastructures

The experiences and innovative knowledge that I have acquired and am acquiring from my involvement in conducting quantitative research and in the development of research projects in the fields of research infrastructures and the management of social data, I highlight them through educational activities that I organize either through EKKE, or through the university departments collaborating with EKKE, or within Sodanet. In the context of the educational activities that I organize at my institution, I am the scientific coordinator and main instructor of the seminar organized by EKKE since 2017 entitled: "Do Your Survey" (<https://doyoursurvey.ekke.gr/>) as well as the research methodology website "HowToSurvey" (<https://www.howtosurvey.gr/>) while at SoDaNet I am responsible for the educational platform <https://elearning.sodanet.gr/>, which hosts courses from all the institutions participating in the network.

The book "Data collection methods using digital questionnaire and survey methodology - Management of online, in-person and telephone surveys and data with Limesurvey and SPSS" will soon be available from the NTUA open access repository - Kallipos, in which I am the main author. The book has largely emerged from the training seminar "Do Your Survey by using quantitative methodologies and tools", in which all three authors participate as lecturers. The book aspires to fill the gap that exists in Greek research methodology books in relation to digital questionnaires and digital case management and the use of research infrastructures in the research process. As the evaluator of the book proposal states: 'its use both by the wider student community and as an alternative to Eudoxos is judged to be one of the strong points of this particular proposal'. The co-authors from the University of Piraeus and the University of Thessaly also intend to use the book in question in their courses.
